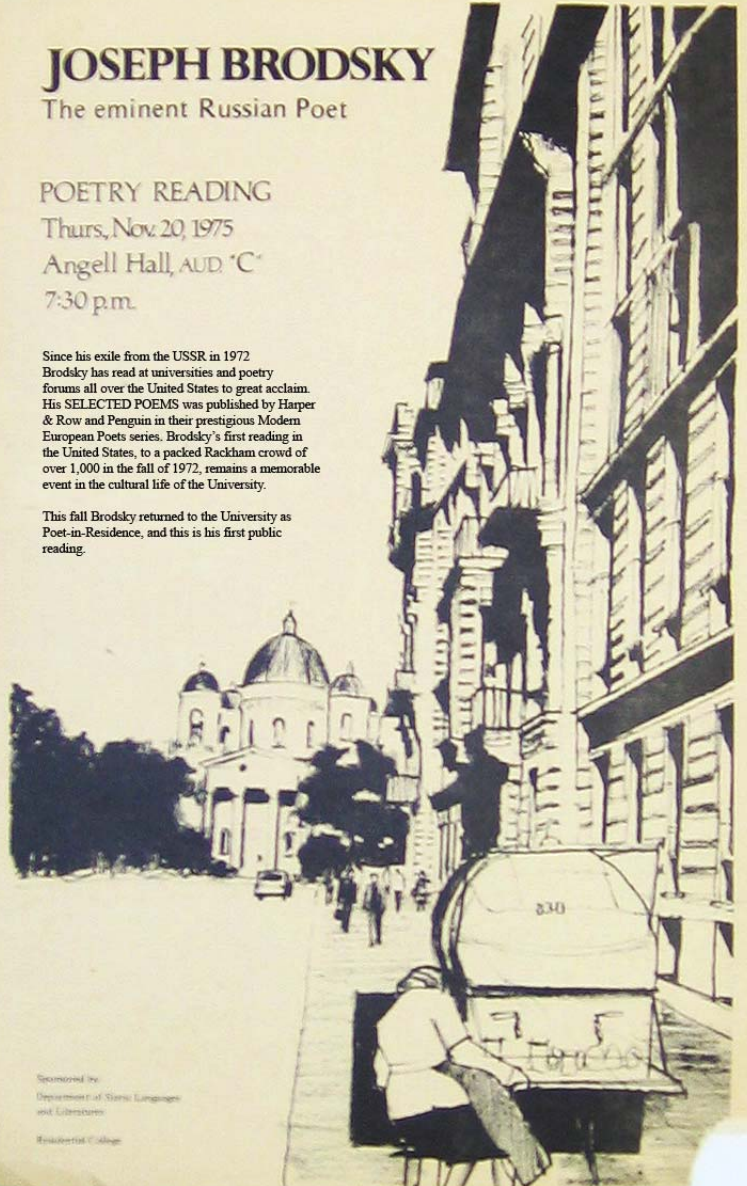

Since his exile from the USSR in 1972 Brodsky has read at universities and poetry forums all over the United States to great acclaim. His **SELECTED POEMS** was published by Harper & Row and Penguin in their prestigious Modern European Poets series. Brodsky's first reading in the United States, to a packed Rackham crowd of over 1,000 in the fall of 1972, remains a memorable event in the cultural life of the University.

This fall Brodsky returned to the University as Poet-in-Residence, and this is his first public reading.
