

UROP Student Grant Application
2009-2010

UROP provides grants to students who do not have work-study as part of a financial aid package but who have **demonstrated financial need**. Many students receive financial aid from the University, but a large portion of it is in the form of loans. Other students receive some financial aid, but the financial aid award notice indicates you still have “unmet financial need”. In other cases, recently changed family circumstances have created financial need, e.g. one of your parents lost his/her job.

To apply for a UROP Grant, provide a letter along with this application form, explaining why a grant is needed to participate in UROP. A copy of your financial aid notice should be included with this application. If you do not receive financial aid, you need to provide another form of documentation of your financial need. If you have any questions about this, please make an appointment to meet with one of the UROP staff to discuss your particular circumstances.

A UROP Grant is the same as work-study. You will be hired as a temporary employee and receive an hourly wage of \$8.50.

UROP Grants are not given to students who would prefer to do UROP for pay vs. credit, e.g. you already have 18 credit hours of other classes.
