Please Note:

1. **Applicants are solely responsible for obtaining and submitting a completed FLAS application** (with any supporting materials) to the appropriate Center in order to be considered for the fellowship competition. This form is **not** a FLAS application. The application deadline is **February 1, 2008**.
2. If you are eligible to receive a FLAS fellowship, you are strongly encouraged to apply for a fellowship, due to the limited fellowship resources in the Department of Anthropology.
3. Students must notify the Department by returning this form that they have or will be competing in the FLAS application process.
4. International students ARE NOT eligible for FLAS fellowships.
5. Students already proficient in a language ARE NOT eligible for a FLAS fellowship in the language of proficiency.
