**The Stanley Frankel Summer Fellowship  
for Research and Study  
in Europe, Israel, or Latin America**

The fellowship, whose value is \$5,000, is open to BA, MA, and PhD students at the University of Michigan who wish to pursue work in Jewish studies during the summer in Europe, Israel, or Latin America. The fellowship may be used for research in archives and libraries, advanced language training, archaeological excavations, scholarly workshops, or social welfare and communal reconstruction projects in countries recovering from authoritarian rule.

Students who wish to apply should submit the following:

- A letter describing the work they have done in Jewish studies at the University of Michigan, and a detailed description of their proposed summer project for which they are requesting financial support
- An itemized budget
- A transcript (an unofficial printout from M-Pathways is acceptable)
- A letter of recommendation, submitted directly to the Frankel Center, from a U-M faculty member with whom they have studied

The deadline is **January 4, 2008**. The winner of the fellowship will be notified in mid-March, 2008.
