-  Do not handle wildlife.
-  Dogs are not permitted except for guide dogs.
-  Bicycles are not permitted on the trails. Please lock bikes at the bike racks near the entrances to the building.
-  Shirt and shoes are required indoors.
-  Alcohol, campfires, and outdoor cooking are not permitted.
-  The Gardens is a non-smoking facility.
