How much Italian Language do I need to take...?

0 semesters: [Florence, Italy \(Spring Music\)](#)

There is no language pre-requisite for this Spring program centering on voice performance. Students live and take classes at the Villa Corsi-Salviati in Sesto Fiorentino.

[Florence, Italy \(Spring Honors\)](#)

There is no language pre-requisite for this Spring program concentrating on two classes created by the Honors program. Readings, discussions, and lectures begin the semester before this program. Students live and take classes at the Villa Corsi-Salviati in Sesto Fiorentino.

[Florence, Italy \(Summer\)](#)

There is no language pre-requisite for this Summer program however an intensive beginner's language class is offered. Other class offers include: drawing, art history, architecture, and Italian culture. Students live and take classes at the Villa Corsi-Salviati in Sesto Fiorentino.

[Rome, Italy \(Fall, Winter\)](#)

There is no Italian language pre-requisite but students must have at least two semesters college-level Greek or Latin for this program. This program is geared towards those students interested in Classical Studies. Course offerings include: Latin, Greek, beginning Italian, and Renaissance and Baroque Art History classes.

[Sicily, Italy \(Fall, Winter\)](#)

There is no language pre-requisite for the program geared towards those students interested in the classics, classical history, or archaeology or art history with a classical background. Course offerings include: Italian, Mediterranean Cultures, Baroque Art & Architecture, History of Modern Sicily, Religions of the Ancient Mediterranean, Greek Philosophy or Medieval Literature.

0-4 semesters: [Florence, Italy \(Fall, Winter, Academic Year\)](#)

In this Academic Year program students must take an Italian language course. Courses are offered from beginning to fourth-semester Italian. Other course offerings include: art history of the Renaissance, Italian literature and history, and modern Italian politics and culture. Students live and take classes at the Villa Corsi-Salviati in Sesto Fiorentino.

4+ semesters: [Padua, Italy \(Academic Year\)](#)

Students begin with an intensive 5-week language program then enroll in classes at the University of Padua or at the program center.
