The University of Michigan furnishes transcripts to non-U-M study abroad programs. The transcripts will show if the student is in academic difficulty.

It is the residence policy of the College of Literature, Science and Arts that a student earn at least 60 semester hours of credit in residence, of which 30 must be earned sometime during the junior or senior year. Credit from programs of accredited universities will transfer provided that:

- 1) Each course grade is C or higher
- 2) The course has not been elected previously
- 3) The work is identical with, or similar to, course work offered by any academic unit of the University of Michigan/Ann Arbor campus. Note that the study abroad work should not be a repetition of work already completed. Avoid taking classes abroad that have similar titles or content to a course you have already taken.

Any work of an internship nature for which credit is desired must be re-reviewed and approved by the University's Admissions Office before transfer credit is authorized.

The Office of International Programs does not have direct access to information about academic probation or disciplinary action against particular students. If the program application requests such information, the office of the Assistant Dean for Student Academic Affairs should be contacted. Hand-written responses to such questions on the application forms will serve as evidence that the information has been obtained from the Assistant Dean's office.
